"Thanks to a \$76,000 grant award through the Office of Gun Violence Prevention, YouthZone will be able to implement our Safe Pathways program, a community-based gun violence initiative focused on interrupting cycles of gun violence, trauma, and retaliation. The program will prevent firearm suicides; provide wraparound services for victims, offenders, and the community to facilitate successful re-entry after a firearm-related incident; and inform citizens of safestorage obligations while respecting their Second Amendment rights."


Join Us at the Glenwood Canyon Brewpub Takeover on November 14th!
